



Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly Food Stamps)

Provides credits on an EBT card to buy food at the grocery store.

- SINGLE - Gross monthly income less than \$1,396 & resources less than \$3,500
- MARRIED - Gross monthly income less than \$1,888 & resources less than \$3,500

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)



Provides one-time payment to the utility company to help with heating costs. Seniors who exceed the guideline are encouraged to apply because they are allowed a medical deduction.

- SINGLE - Gross monthly income less than \$2,211 & resources less than \$3,000
- MARRIED - Gross monthly income less than \$2,891 & resources less than \$3,000



PLEASE NOTE!

Gross income is the total amount of income before any deductions are applied. Social Security, wages, IRA disbursements, interest income, pensions, etc. are all income considered.

These important money saving programs can help put money back into your pocket.



Missouri Property Tax Credit (MO-PTC)

Must be 65 or 100% disabled and a Missouri resident for the entire year. Rent Rebate: Qualified persons may receive up to \$750 based on the rent paid.

- ___ SINGLE – Gross income less than \$27,500
- ___ MARRIED – Gross income less than \$29,500

Real Estate Property Tax Rebate for homeowners: May receive up to \$1,100.

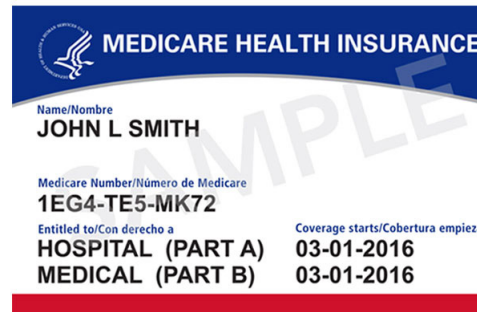
- ___ SINGLE - \$30,000
- ___ MARRIED - \$34,000

Extra Help or Low-Income Subsidy (LIS)



Reduces Medicare Part D premiums, deductibles, drug co-pays and eliminates coverage gap or doughnut hole.

- ___ SINGLE - Gross monthly income less than \$1,756 & resources less than \$15,510
- ___ MARRIED - Gross monthly income less than \$2,329 & resources less than \$30,950



Medicare Savings Program

(three levels-QMB, SLMB, QI-1)
Pays Medicare Part B premium.

- ___ SINGLE - Gross monthly income less than \$1,549 & resources less than \$8,400
- ___ MARRIED - Gross monthly income less than \$2,080 & resources less than \$12,600



Mo HealthNet (Medicaid)

Pays medical services (secondary to Medicare). Incomes higher than the amounts listed may qualify as a spend down status (pay a premium before MO HealthNet will pay for services). You do not have to have Medicare to be eligible for MO HealthNet.

- ___ SINGLE - Gross monthly income less than \$983 & resources less than \$5,035
- ___ MARRIED - Gross monthly income less than \$1,317 & resources less than \$10,070

NEW Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHWAP)

One-time payment to your account for utilities.

- ___ SINGLE – Gross income less than \$2,211 & resources less than \$3,000
- ___ MARRIED – Gross income less than \$2,891 & resources less than \$3,000

NEW Expanded Medicaid (AEG)

For individuals 19-64 and not receiving medicare.

- ___ SINGLE – Gross income less than \$1,481 & no resource limit
- ___ MARRIED – Gross income less than \$2,003 & no resource limit
